INFORMATION

All courses offered for Summer School 2020 are online and are tuition free. Registration starts May 11 and ends May 27 and is available through your high school counselor. ***Summer School 2020 is open only to current CFISD high school students.***

ORIGINAL CREDIT

Registration

- Registration is based on current 2019-2020 grade level.
- Students must have approval from their grade-level counselor before signing up for original-credit courses.
- Only current CFISD students may register for high school summer school.

Credits

Students may earn ½ High School L-level (on-level) credit each session. **To earn credit for the course, students must complete the entirety of the course.**

Course Offerings

Students must be eligible to take the course during the 2020-2021 school year in order to enroll in an original-credit course in the summer. If fewer than 20 students enroll in a course, students will be notified and can change their course selection to another available summer school course.

Considerations

MAKE-UP CREDIT

Registration

- Registration is based on current 2019-2020 grade level.
- Students should register as early as possible to reserve space in a class.
- Only current CFISD students may register for high school summer school.

Credits

Students may take two make-up credit courses, one in Session I and one in Session II. **To get credit for the course, students may not be absent more than 2 days during each session. Reminder: One day in summer school equals seven days in the regular school term.**

Registration
